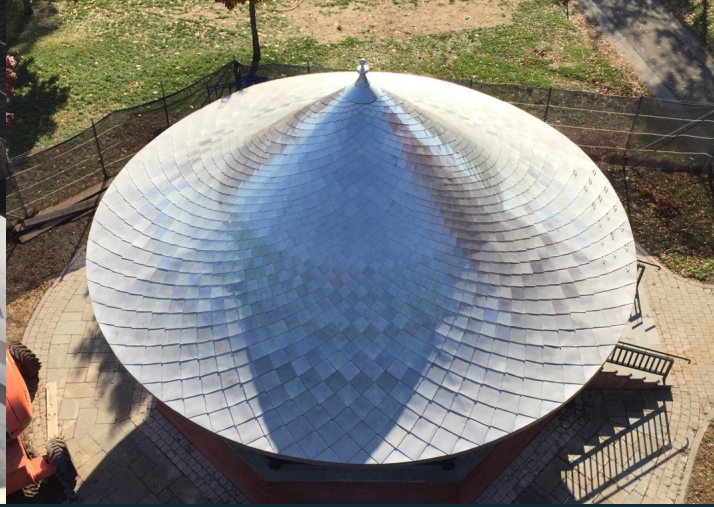

Terne is an old English word for tin (the metal). Terne clad (coated) stainless steel, or terne metal to which it is often referred in the industry is a special metal often used in restoration contexts, but has many applications.



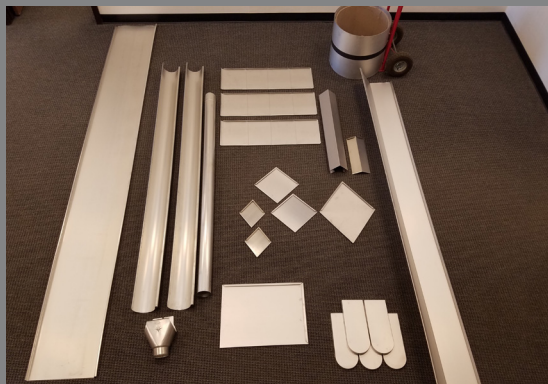
Terne weathers in its environment providing a soft, gray patina.
